



Mass Intention Request Form 2022

Thank you for requesting a Mass intention for a loved one who has died or a loved one who is living and is in need of prayer. At every celebration of the Eucharist, all our intentions are placed on the Lord's altar whether these intentions are mentioned or not mentioned. This is an ancient Catholic practice. The designated Mass intention will be the principal intention at a specified common Sunday or weekday celebration of the Eucharist. A designated Mass intention is not the only intention at that Mass. The assembly prays for everyone's intentions and our common intentions in the Prayer of the Faithful.

- Requests for Mass intentions will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis in the order in which this form is received at the parish office
- A \$15 stipend per Mass Intention is customary, and should accompany each request (*checks must have "Mass Intentions" in the memo*)
- While we will do everything we can to accommodate your requested date, we cannot guarantee that.
- If you circle "living," the Mass Intention will show the person's name. If you circle "deceased" we will show a small cross "(+)" before the person's name when listed in the parish bulletin.
- We can only accept Mass Intentions through the calendar year 2023.
- A maximum of six (6) intentions per year from **any one individual** may be scheduled at the parish with no more than two (2) scheduled for a weekend Mass.
- A maximum of six (6) Masses per year may be scheduled at the parish for **any one intention** from **any one individual**.
- A Mass intention may be requested for a Mass for:
 1. a deceased human person; a living person who is sick or suffering or in need of prayer
 2. a general intention, e.g. *World Peace, Military Families, Deceased Members of a Family*, etc.
 3. in thanksgiving to God;
 4. A Mass intention may not be requested for an intention that contradicts Catholic teaching.
 5. A Mass intention may not be scheduled for an unknown, "special" or "private" intention.
